Moses inspired Pam’s talk. His life showed that during times of solitude, inactivity and unproductiveness, God was preparing him for His important work. Moses met YAHWEH, I AM who AM, the God who IS, when God spoke to him from a burning bush. This was holy ground. Wilderness lessons are the exact lessons we have to learn on our journey to God. 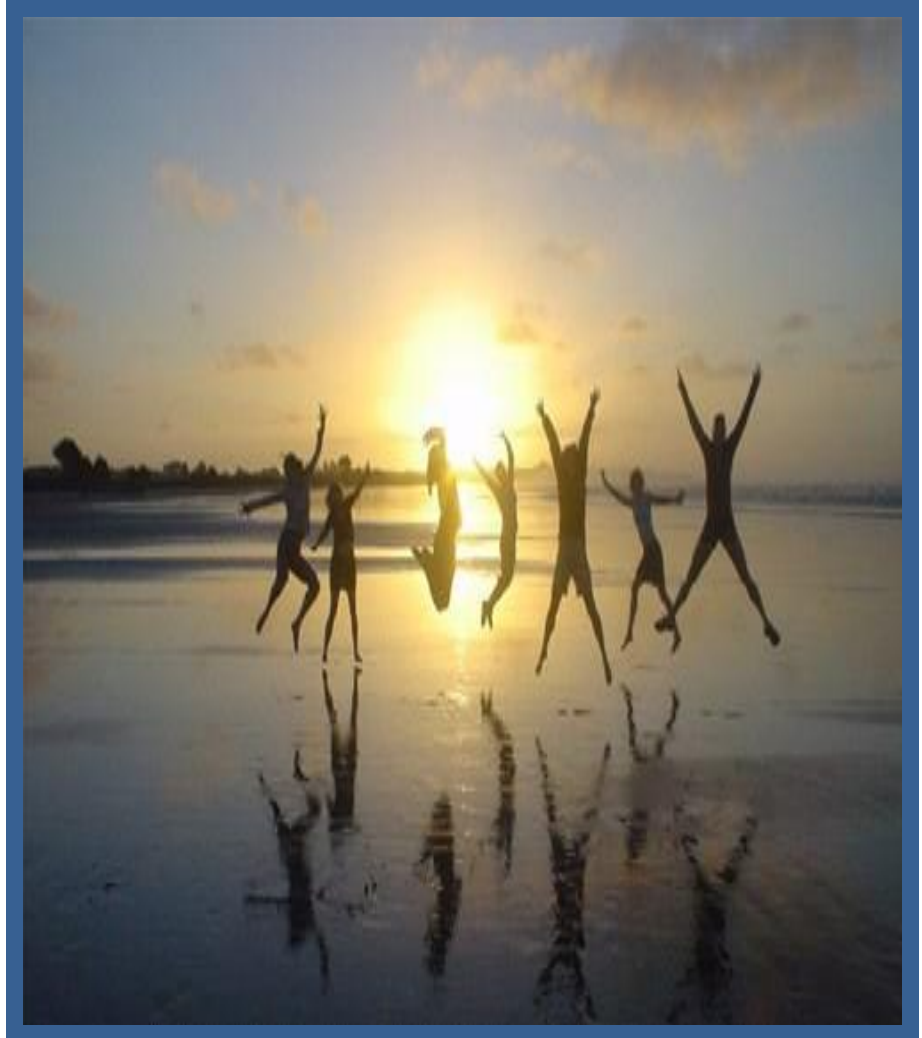
