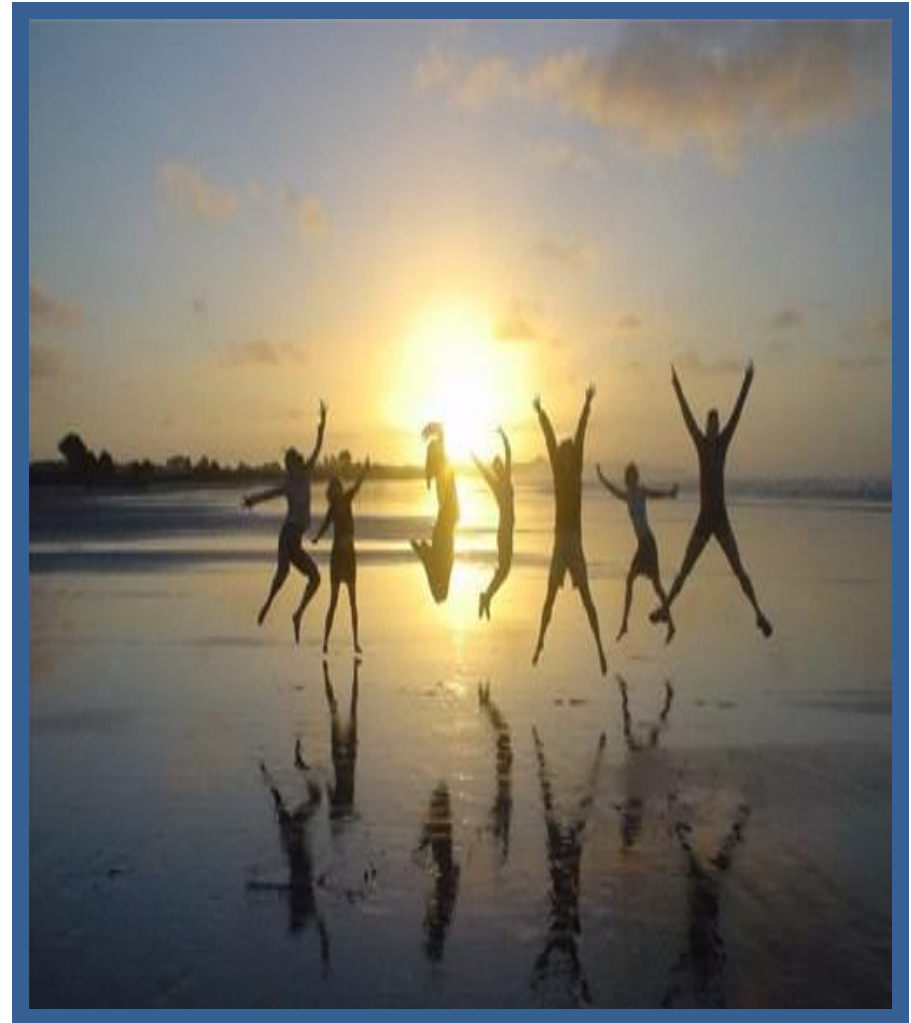
Margaret responded to a word of knowledge which led her to prayer ministry with a good outcome and gave thanks to God and the caring national Dove Team.
