Terry has taught workshops and directed retreats since 1989 and has gained a reputation for inspirational teaching and spiritual leadership. Terry's website is www.gnm.org

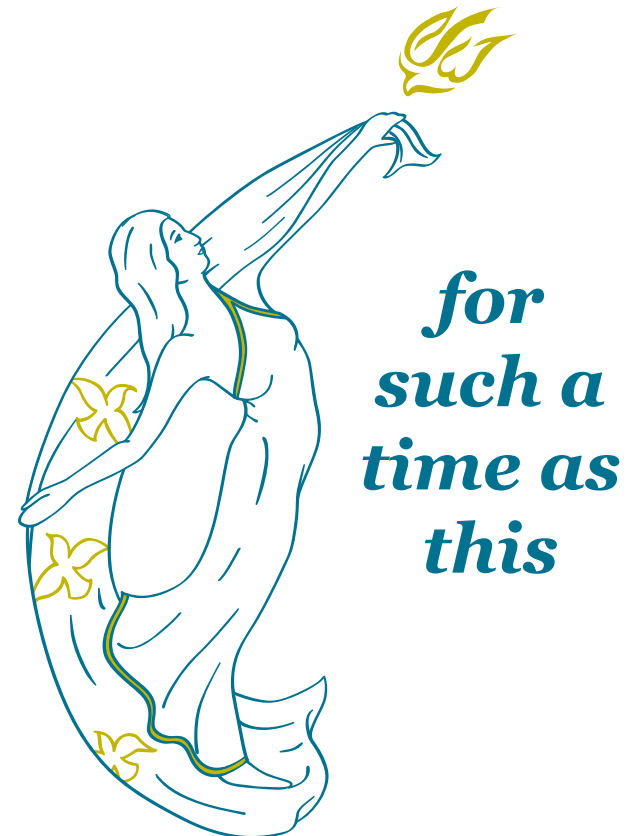
