JESUS THE LIVING WATER

Revelations 22:1-2, 16-17

The living water that Jesus provides will sustain us. Jesus took our thirst away by dying to His. His thirst was not completely satisfied until He died on the cross, thereby completing His Father's mission. It is from this act that Jesus' living water flows to give us new life. It is Jesus' water (spirited water) that reveals to us the truth behind His words and signs and allows us to trust its source. The source is God.
