The dvd on Psalms 139 touched my heart and had more tears rolling down my cheeks. I lovely lady next to me grabbed my hand and held it for a long time and more tears rolled down my cheeks. I was encouraged and blessed by some people coming up to me and giving me cuddles and asking if I was ok, through these people approaching with care I saw the love of the Father come from them.
